Upon finalizing the agreement with Georgia Tech, CGC will contribute, pursuant to the TRA's November 8, 2010 Final Order in this Docket, \$20,000 annually from asset management funds, when available, during the three-year trial period to Georgia Tech's Sustainable Thermal Systems Lab for research and development of a device that will conserve energy. CGC provided information regarding this proprietary research in the Confidential Exhibit that was filed along with CGC's January 7, 2011 Report. CGC will notify the Tennessee Regulatory Authority once the agreement with Georgia Tech is finalized.
