
A **Status Conference** has been scheduled at **1:30 p.m. (CDT) on July 9, 2013** in the Hearing Room on the Ground Floor of the Offices of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority at 460 James Robertson Parkway, Nashville, Tennessee. The status conference is being held to: 1) determine the issues proposed for resolution in this proceeding, 2) establish a procedural schedule, and 3) consider other relevant pending matters, if any.

To facilitate an efficient use of time during the status conference, the parties are directed to file by **2:00 p.m. (CDT) on July 8, 2013**, a joint proposed issues list and procedural schedule for the Hearing Officer's review and consideration. If, after engaging in discussion and attempting to reach agreement, any party is unable to agree as to either the issues or a procedural schedule, such party shall separately file a proposed issues list and/or proposed procedural schedule by the day and time noted above.

Any person desiring to participate in this status conference must file a petition to intervene in the docket file in accordance with Tenn. Code Ann. §§ 4-5-310 and 65-2-107. Any party or interested person of record that would like to participate by telephone may do so by emailing the Hearing Officer at kelly.grams@tn.gov and copying Sharla Dillon, Docket Manager, at sharla.dillon@tn.gov. All parties are entitled to be represented by counsel.
