Code Ann. §§ 65-5-103(a) and (d), the Hearing Officer finds that the effectiveness of the proposed tariff filed by Chattanooga Gas Company on October 20, 2017, which reflects an effective date of December 1, 2017, should be suspended **through and including February 1, 2018**, or until further order of the Commission, whichever occurs sooner.
