(1) Have applicants filed similar applications or notices in other states? If so, provide a listing of states and actions taken.

Answer:

Yes, the applicants filed similar applications or notices in the following states: Georgia, Mississippi, Ohio, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Alabama. These currently are pending. The applicants also anticipate filings in at least the following states: Arkansas, Florida, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Missouri, and Oklahoma.

(2) Have applicants filed a similar application with the FCC? If so, list any action taken and the associated docket number. If a schedule to complete the review of your application has been established by the FCC, provide such with your response.

Answer:

Yes, the applicants filed a similar petition with the FCC on November 18, 2009. The FCC has assigned docket number WC 09-211. It is anticipated that the international application will be automatically granted pursuant to streamlined processing 15 days after public notice of the application. Although the domestic application is not eligible for streamlined processing, it is anticipated that the FCC will approve the domestic application in approximately 6 weeks.
