ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENT TO THE STAND-ALONE INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the “Authority”), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on December 14, 2009 to consider the Petition for approval of the Amendment to the Stand-Alone Interconnection Agreement negotiated between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Tennessee and ITC^DeltaCom Communications, Inc. d/b/a ITC^DeltaCom d/b/a Grapevine (the “Company”)¹ filed on November 17, 2009.²

Based upon a review of the Amendment, the record in this matter, and the standards for review set forth in 47 U.S.C. § 252, the Directors made findings consistent with those in the *Order Approving Stand-Alone Interconnection Agreement* issued on January 12, 2005 in Docket No. 04-00277 and unanimously granted the Petition.
