


ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENT
TO THE INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT


This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director Mary W. Freeman of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on January 11, 2010, to consider the Petition for approval of the Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement negotiated between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Tennessee and MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC¹ filed on December 8, 2009.²

Based upon a review of the Amendment, the record in this matter, and the standards for review set forth in 47 U.S.C. § 252, the Directors made findings consistent with those in the *Order Approving the Interconnection Agreement* issued on February 1, 2007 in Docket No. 06-00287 and unanimously granted the Petition.
