ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

This matter came before Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director James M. Allison of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on September 15, 2014. Reunion Communications, Inc. ("Reunion" or the "Company") originally filed an Application for authority to resell interexchange long distance telecommunications services in Tennessee on December 14, 2009. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on January 11, 2010, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On September 2, 2014, the TRA received a request from Reunion to cancel its authority. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.
