Dear Ms. Cashman-Grams:

On behalf of IntelePeer, Inc. ("IntelePeer"), in response to your letter dated April 8, 2010 in Docket No. 09-00201, IntelePeer hereby provides the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("Authority") with a detailed status report on IntelePeer's compliance with the requirement that it obtain either an irrevocable letter of credit or corporate surety bond in the amount of \$20,000, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-125(j).

Because several other states where IntelePeer is seeking to obtain authority to provide telecommunications services also require that IntelePeer obtain a letter of credit, IntelePeer is in the final stages of securing these letters of credit with Comerica Bank. IntelePeer expects to have the letters of credit secured by the end of April, barring any unforeseen issues arising. If unforeseen circumstances were to arise, IntelePeer anticipates securing the letters of credit no later than the end of May 2010.

In consideration of these circumstances, IntelePeer hereby waives the 60 day statutory requirement for the entry of an order in this docket.
