## MOTION FOR ORDER ADMINISTRATIVELY CLOSING DOCKET

This case arises out of unpaid charges for telecommunication services provided by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Tennessee ("AT&T Tennessee") to Tennessee Telephone Service dba Freedom Communications USA LLC ("Freedom") for resale pursuant to the terms of interconnection agreements (the "ICAs") which were approved by the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"). 1

On August 5, 2010, Freedom provided the Authority and AT&T with a Notice of Filing Bankruptcy.<sup>2</sup> In light of the bankruptcy filing, AT&T Tennessee requests that the Authority enter an order stating that this docket is administratively closed without prejudice to AT&T Tennessee's right to pursue collection for unpaid amounts against Freedom or any other entity in the Bankruptcy Court or other appropriate judicial forum.
