Gentlemen:

In recent conversations regarding the above-styled docket, you both have advised that there is no dispute between the parties regarding the facts in this matter. As such, you each have indicated that there is no need for the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA") to conduct an evidentiary hearing in this docket. Based upon these representations, it appears that two courses of action are available to the parties through the TRA: (1) mediation or (2) oral argument before the panel assigned to this docket, followed by a decision on the merits. If the parties decide to proceed to oral argument, then the parties should prepare and file in this docket a Joint Stipulation of Facts containing uncontested facts which the parties deem relevant and material to the allegations in the Complaint and the defenses raised in the Answer.

Please respond to this letter within seven (7) days, advising whether the parties desire mediation or have decided to file a Joint Stipulation and proceed to oral argument. Please file your response in the docket file.
