Hill of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on March 22, 2010 for consideration of the *Petition* filed by Piedmont Natural Gas Company, Inc. on February 2, 2010 requesting approval of a negotiated Gas Redelivery Agreement with Bridgestone Americas Tire Operation, LLC (formerly Bridgestone/Firestone).
