AGREED MOTION TO HOLD PROCEEDINGS IN ABEYANCE

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. dba AT&T Tennessee ("AT&T Tennessee") hereby

respectfully submits this Agreed Motion to Hold Proceedings in Abeyance, and requests that the

Authority hold this matter in abeyance until January 10, 2011. All parties to this proceeding

have consented to this motion. In support of this motion, AT&T Tennessee further states as

follows:

1. The parties, Sprint Spectrum, L.P. dba Sprint PCS and Nextel South Corp.

(collectively "Sprint") and AT&T Tennessee, have engaged in discussions in an effort to settle

the dispute giving rise to AT&T Tennessee's complaint in this matter.

2. The parties have agreed that a temporary abeyance of this proceeding, and of

similar proceedings initiated in other states by some of AT&T Tennessee's incumbent local

exchange carrier ("ILEC") affiliates against Sprint and/or affiliates of Sprint, may facilitate a

multi-state settlement of the complaints of AT&T Tennessee and its ILEC affiliates.

3. In connection with the parties' settlement discussions, Sprint has agreed to

provide certain additional data to AT&T Tennessee and its ILEC affiliates by December 6, 2010,

and the parties have further agreed that neither will seek to reactivate these proceedings prior

to January 10, 2011, provided AT&T receives the additional data from Sprint on or before December 6, 2010.

4. AT&T Tennessee reserves the right to seek reactivation of this matter prior to January 10, 2011, in the event that Sprint does not provide the additional data discussed by the parties on or before December 6, 2010.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, AT&T Tennessee respectfully requests that the Authority hold this proceeding in abeyance until January 10, 2011. AT&T Tennessee is authorized to state that Sprint consents to this requested relief.
