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**ORDER GRANTING APPROVAL OF NAME CHANGE**


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This matter came before Chairman Mary W. Freeman, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Sara Kyle of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on August 23, 2010 to consider the petition of Stellar Nordia Services, LLC ("Stellar Nordia" or "Company") to change its name.


At a Hearing held on December 3, 2007 in Docket No. 07-00254, Stellar Nordia was granted authority to provide competing local telecommunications services in order to act as a call center subcontractor for GoAmerica Relay Services Corp. ("GoAmerica") with respect to GoAmerica's provision of intrastate telecommunications relay services within Tennessee. On April 9, 2010, Stellar Nordia filed a Petition to change the name under which it provides telecommunications services in Tennessee to Stellar Relay, LLC.

Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter and upon a finding that the Company has satisfied the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-1-.08, the panel voted unanimously to approve the name change.


