


ORDER DISMISSING PETITION AND CLOSING DOCKET

This matter came before Chairman Eddie Roberson, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director Mary W. Freeman of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on July 11, 2011 to consider dismissal of the *Petition of Knology, Inc. and Knology of Knoxville, Inc., to Establish Terms and Conditions of Public, Educational and Governmental Channel Access with Comcast Cable* ("Petition"). On June 15, 2011, the parties filed a letter notifying the Authority that they had reached an agreement on the specific public, educational and governmental ("PEG") access matters raised in the *Petition* and that the Knology entities were requesting that the *Petition* be dismissed without any waiver on the part of the Knology entities to raise subsequent PEG access matters should they arise. Based on the foregoing, the panel voted unanimously to dismiss the *Petition* and to close the docket.
