TO THE INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT


This matter came before Director Mary W. Freeman, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on June 21, 2010, to consider the Petition for approval of the Amendments to the Interconnection Agreement negotiated between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Tennessee¹ and XO Communications Services, Inc. filed on April 28, 2010.²

Based upon a review of the Amendments, the record in this matter, and the standards for review set forth in 47 U.S.C. § 252, the Directors made findings consistent with those in the *Order Denying BellSouth's Motion to Reject Certain Provisions of Interconnection Agreement and Approving Interconnection Agreement, as Amended* issued on August 29, 2000 in Docket No. 98-00123 and unanimously granted the Petition.
