Thank you for your letter of April 29, 2010 concerning the dispute between Nexus Communications d/b/a Reachout Wireless and the Universal Service Administration Company (USAC) in Washington, D.C. My office has received several calls from constituents about this issue and I am glad to see that the TRA is in a position to resolve it quickly.

I met today with Mr. Steven Fenker, the President of Nexus and Mr. Chuck Welch, the Company's attorney. They explained to me that even though this dispute is still pending before the TRA, USAC has decided to cut off federal support which Nexus has been receiving and which allows Nexus to provide wireless telephone service to about 34,000 Tennesseans. Mr. Fenker explained that the petition filed by Nexus at the TRA asks the Authority to request that USAC restore funding for Nexus' Lifeline wireless subscribers in Tennessee until the TRA has had the opportunity to look into the issues in the dispute between USAC and Nexus.

The service Nexus is providing is vital to many low income Tennesseans. Although I know that the TRA has no control over the administrators at USAC, I hope you can persuade them to avoid any action which might interrupt the telephone services provided by Nexus until the TRA has resolved this matter and made a final decision that is consistent with the law and in the best interests of Tennessee consumers.
