Mr. Hyatt:

As we discussed, surety carriers are becoming increasingly tight on their capacity and underwriting requirements. Much of this is due to the increased losses they are incurring from the current economic conditions. We have contacted all of our commercial bonding carriers including, but not limited to, The Travelers, The Hartford, Westfield, North American Specialty, Houston Casualty and Great American. Most of these carriers are unwilling to consider the \$1,000,000 Tennessee Utility Bond you requested. There is one that will consider it but the terms and conditions are certainly unfavorable.

- 1) Complete audited Financial Statement with net worth of at least \$500,000;
- 2) Signed Indemnification by both the membership of the LLC, the owners personally and their spouses;
- 3) Cash Collateral in the amount of 50% of the bond face amount (\$500,000).
