TO THE INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT**




This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Mary W. Freeman of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on June 21, 2010, to consider the Petition for approval of the Amendments to the Interconnection Agreement negotiated between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Tennessee<sup>1</sup> and American Fiber Systems, Inc. filed on May 21, 2010.<sup>2</sup>

Based upon a review of the Amendments, the record in this matter, and the standards for review set forth in 47 U.S.C. § 252, the Directors made findings consistent with those in the *Order Approving the Interconnection Agreement* issued on March 17, 2003 in Docket No. 02-01273 and unanimously granted the Petition.
