RESPONSE TO STAFF DATA REQUEST

1. Have the Petitioners filed similar petitions or notices in other states? If so, provide a listing of states and action taken.

Response:

Global Crossing Local Services, Inc. ("GCLS") is certified or registered in 26 states. Global Crossing Telemanagement, Inc. ("GCTM") is certified, registered or otherwise authorized to provide local service in 37 jurisdictions. Petitions for approval or pre-merger notifications have been filed in all jurisdictions in which both companies operate, as required. In jurisdictions where GCTM is the only entity, either new applications or requests for transfer of certification to GCLS have been or will be filed. In addition, post transaction notifications as required or requested, as well as filings to cancel GCTM's authority, will be submitted following the merger.

2. Provide a copy of the self-certification letter filed with the FCC in CC Docket No. 00-257 regarding transfer of customers.

Response:

No FCC filing related to transfer of customers has been or will be made. Such a filing is not required under the FCC's rules in this instance because GCTM does not provide interstate or international services and the transaction is only an internal corporate reorganization. A copy of the proposed customer notice was included in the petition for approval.

3. Provide the number of customers that Global Crossing Telemanagement, Inc. ("GCTM") currently serves in Tennessee.

4. Will all GCTM customers in Tennessee be transferred into Global Crossing Local Services, Inc. ("GCLS")?




