


ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENT
TO THE INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT


This matter came before Chairman Mary W. Freeman, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on July 26, 2010 to consider the Petition for approval of the Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement negotiated between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Tennessee and Cincinnati Bell Any Distance, Inc. filed on June 17, 2010.¹

Based upon a review of the Amendment, the record in this matter, and the standards for review set forth in 47 U.S.C. § 252, the Directors made findings consistent with those in the *Order Approving the Interconnection Agreement* issued on February 3, 2010 in Docket No. 10-00003 and unanimously granted the Petition.
