Dear Ms. Talley:

On June 30, 2010, the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA") received your application on behalf of Twin Lakes Communications, Inc. ("TLCI") for a state-issued certificate of franchise authority pursuant to the Competitive Cable and Video Services Act ("CCVSA").¹ Because TLCI is not included in the group of providers who are deemed by "operation of law to have the managerial, financial, and technical qualifications to obtain a state-issued certificate of franchise authority,"² TRA Staff sent a letter to TLCI on July 15, 2010 requesting further information by which to evaluate TLCI's managerial, financial, and technical qualifications. On October 8, 2010 the TRA received the *Managerial, Financial, and Technical Qualifications of Twin Lakes Communications, Inc.*

Upon further review, it has been determined that the application now complies with the statutory requirements of the CCVSA and is therefore complete. Further action will be taken on the application as delineated within the CCVSA.
