Dear Hearing Officer Grams:

Pursuant to the April 3, 2012 request for the current status of this matter, please be advised that Everycall Communications ("Everycall") has assumed its contracts with AT&T subject to a negotiated cure amount. The bankruptcy court approved the settlement on March 19, 2012, which calls for the following:

- (a) Everycall will dismiss the instant docket, without prejudice;
- (b) Everycall will also move to dismiss its bankruptcy case; and
- (c) AT&T is required to dismiss Everycall from all of the dockets filed in the southeast states in which AT&T is seeking payment from Everycall, since the parties have agreed to a specific amount Everycall will pay AT&T. AT&T did not file suit against Everycall in Tennessee.
