ORDER ADMINISTRATIVELY CLOSING DOCKET

This matter is before the Hearing Officer following the response to the Hearing Officer's request for the current status of EveryCall Communications, Inc.'s ("EveryCall") bankruptcy proceeding¹ and reasons the docket should remain open, filed by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Tennessee ("AT&T") on April 13, 2012. In its response, AT&T states that EveryCall has assumed its contracts with AT&T subject to a negotiated cure amount (settlement). In addition, AT&T stated that the settlement, approved by the bankruptcy court on March 19, 2012, requires that EveryCall dismiss the instant docket and its bankruptcy case, and that AT&T dismiss EveryCall from all dockets that AT&T has filed that seek payment from EveryCall.² According to the bankruptcy docket file, on March 2, 2012, EveryCall's bankruptcy petition was dismissed on its own motion, subject upon entry of the order approving EveryCall's



settlement with AT&T.³ Finally, EveryCall has neither responded to the Hearing Officer's request, nor objected to the response to that request filed by AT&T.

Upon due consideration and for the foregoing reasons, the Hearing Officer hereby administratively closes the docket file.
