Re: Docket No. 10-00137; Application for Approval of the Transfer of DukeNet Communications, LLC's Certificate to Provide Local Exchange and Interexchange Telecommunications Services as a Competitive Local Exchange Carrier to DukeNet OpCo

Dear Mr. Kettles:

The applicants submit the following response to Staff Data Request No. 1.

1. Have the Applicants filed a similar application or notice in other states? If so, provide a listing of states and actions taken.

RESPONSE: Applications for approval are pending in Virginia, South Carolina, and Georgia. Notices, not requiring agency action, have been or will be filed in Alabama and North Carolina.

2. Have the Applicants made a similar filing with the FCC? If so, provide or list any action taken by the FCC, and the associated docket number. If a schedule to complete the review of the filing has been established by the FCC, provide such with your response.

RESPONSE: An application (WC Docket No. 10-139) was filed at the FCC and was approved for a streamlined pleading cycle set for approval by operation of law on August 30, 2010. No parties have intervened. On August 20, 2010, the FCC displaced the application from the streamlined pleading cycle to give the U.S. Department of Justice some additional time to complete its review of the application.

3. Provide a copy of the definitive agreement the Applicants entered into defining joint venture description in the *Application*.

RESPONSE: The agreement and attachments are over 1,000 pages long and confidential. A verified description of the agreement which describes the transaction will be filed shortly, under seal.

4. How many customers are currently served by DukeNet Communications, LLC ("DukeNet") in Tennessee?

103939-000002 7/2419145.2 **RESPONSE:** There are no retail customers in Tennessee and only one wholesale customer.

5. Provide a copy of the customer notification letter that includes language consistent with TRA Rule 1220-4-2.56(2)(d)(4) and indicating that unless the customer selects and telecommunications service provider, the customer's local or long distance service will be transferred to the acquiring telecommunications provider as required by TRA Rule 1220-4-2.56(2)(d)(2).

RESPONSE: Not applicable since there are no retail customers in Tennessee.

6. Provide a copy of the self certification letter filed with the FCC in CC Docket 00-257 concerning transfer of customer base.

RESPONSE: That FCC requirement is not applicable to this transaction, according to the FCC staff.

7. Provide signed verifications from the Applicants verifying that the information contained in the *Application* is true to their best knowledge, information and belief.

RESPONSE: The verifications will be filed shortly.

8. Provide a \$20,000 corporate surety bond, irrevocable letter of credit or sufficient documentation to demonstrate compliance with T.C.A. §65-4-125 company resulting from the merger of DukeNet OpCo., LLC ("OpCo") and DukeNet.

RESPONSE: The bond will be provided shortly.

9. Provide a copy of OpCo's license to do business in Tennessee.

RESPONSE: DukeNet OpCo, LLC's license to do business in Tennessee is attached.

10. Will the company resulting from the merger of OpCo and DukeNet adopt DukeNet's existing tariff?

RESPONSE: Yes, DukeNet OpCo will adopt the existing tariffs of DukeNet Communications.

- 11. To demonstrate the financial qualifications of the company resulting from the merger of OpCo and DukeNet, provide the following information:
- (a) The estimated cost of network facilities including switches and unbundled network elements.

RESPONSE: The aggregate estimated cost of network facilities in Tennessee for 2010 and 2011 is \$7.8 million.

(b) The most recent audited financial statements (balance sheet, income statement and statement of cash flow).

RESPONSE: To date, DukeNet OpCo has not had operations and therefore, has no audited financial statements.

(c) Projected financial statements (balance sheet, income statement and statement of cash flow) for the next three years.

RESPONSE: Certain financial projections that were recently used by DukeNet in presentations to potential investors and lenders will be filed shortly.

(d) A capital expenditures budget for the next three years detailing equipment to be deployed, the cost of equipment and the source of funding.

RESPONSE: A capital expenditure budget for DukeNet will be included in the financial projections to be filed in response to (c) above.
