
DATE: July 27, 2011

Code Ann. § 65-4-201, a hearing is hereby scheduled in the above-captioned matter for **Monday, August 22, 2011 during the Authority Conference beginning at 1:00 p.m.** in the Hearing Room on the Ground Floor at 460 James Robertson Parkway, Nashville, Tennessee. The hearing will be conducted in accordance with the Tennessee Uniform Administrative Procedures Act, Tenn. Freeman have been assigned as the voting panel to conduct the hearing and deliberate the merits of this Petition.

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

Responses to the Following shall be Addressed in Pre-filed Sworn Testimony ~

1. Discuss in detail the type of wastewater system Aqua Green Utility, Inc. proposes for construction, which will support the 50 homes anticipated for service, in Jefferson County, Tennessee, at Stonebridge on Douglas Lake.
2. Provide a copy of the construction/engineering drawings that have been approved and stamped by The Tennessee Department of Environmental Conservation.
3. Provide a timeline for construction of the wastewater system. (The information provided by Aqua Green Utility, Inc. in its original Petition conflicts with its data response filed with the Authority on May 5, 2011 to Data Request #1).
4. Explain how Aqua Green Utility, Inc. proposes to provide wastewater services to the six existing homes (that currently are using pump and haul) until the wastewater system is constructed and operational.
5. Identify the construction costs of the wastewater treatment system to date, and provide a detailed listing of parts, labor, etc. that have been funded to-date by the Developer.
6. Provide a copy of the most recent bank statement for Aqua Green Utility, Inc.
7. Provide a copy of the most recent bank statement for Advanced Septic, Inc.
8. In the event that the Developer does not honor the payment arrangements as set forth in the contract that has been executed between Advanced Septic, Inc., Aqua Green Utility, Inc., and the Developer, describe the funding options that will be used to construct an operational wastewater treatment system.
