

Dear Mr. Kendall:

I understand that there are still issues involving the state operation permit (SOP) for Stonebridge, some of which may have impact relative to engineering plans review and approval. Therefore, in an attempt to try to avoid any misunderstandings regarding the engineering plans approval process, I offer the following comments for your consideration:

- By letter dated September 22, 2010, you submitted "sewer system lines as builts" to our Permit Section to be added to your SOP-10042 application. "As built" plans are not part of a State Operating Permit application. As built plans are submitted after completion of work to reflect all alterations to a design that was approved prior to construction. It is illegal to build and/or modify any portion of a wastewater treatment plant and/or collection system without prior construction approval from the Division of Water Pollution Control (WPC).
- WPC will not approve any engineering plans until a permit has been issued. To be approved the engineering plans must be in concert with the issued permit.
- Your submittal dated September 22, 2010, showed a schematic drawing of the wastewater treatment system and collection system for 112 lots at Stonebridge. At the present time, draft SOP-10042 that went on public notice on February 22, 2011, would allow only 55 lots to be served by the permitted system. Therefore, if this SOP is issued, engineering plans will have to be submitted delineating which 55 lots would be served by

the treatment system. The total number of SOP permitted lots must be identified on engineering plans prepared, stamped and signed by a registered professional engineer licensed to practice engineering in the State of Tennessee. These lots must be contiguous lots. The approved collection system cannot encompass more lots than permitted by the SOP.

 The engineering plans/drawings shall be much more comprehensive than a schematic drawing. Per Chapter 1200-4-2-.05(2), final plans and specifications shall be prepared in accordance with generally accepted wastewater engineering practices. Plans, at a minimum, must show plan and profile views and sufficient details to determine the efficacy of the proposed wastewater treatment plant and collection system.
