TRA Question 1(a):

List each state in which dPi is providing or has requested authority to provide local exchange service.

Response 1(a):

dPi is providing CLEC wireline services in the following states:

Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, California, Connecticut, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Mississippi, Missouri, Nevada, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Virginia, West Virginia, and Wisconsin.

dPi is certified but is not providing service in the following states:

Hawaii, Idaho, Iowa, New Mexico, Utah, Vermont, and Washington.

dPi has been denied ETC status in Tennessee. dPi previously filed in Tennessee a combined application for Wireline and Wireless in Docket No. 10-00088. The Tennessee Regulatory Authority (TRA) directed dPi to refile its application, for Wireline only, and file with FCC for Wireless. As noted above Wireline designation is currently pending here in Tennessee. dPi withdrew its ETC request for Wireless designation in Florida Docket No. 100071-TP and South Carolina (Docket No. 2008-31-C). As noted in Attachment "A", dPi has Wireline ETC designation in Florida (Docket No. 100071-TP) and South Carolina (Docket No. 2008-31-C).

TRA Question 1(c):

Does dPi currently provide local exchange service in any state where it has not requested or received ETC designation? Please explain.

Response 1(c):

dPi currently provides local exchange in the following states where it has not requested or received ETC designation:

Arizona, California, Connecticut, Delaware, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Nevada, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Virginia, West Virginia, and Wisconsin.
