The City of Chattanooga filed its Third Motion to Compel on Friday, January 7, 2011 addressing the production of documents listed on Tennessee American Water Company's Privilege Log. During the editing process, the final paragraph of that Motion was changed in a manner that creates a potential for confusion for the relief being sought.

By this letter, we wish to clarify that as set forth in detail in footnote 3 on page 5 of the City of Chattanooga's Third Motion to Compel, the City seeks an order compelling production of items 2 through 96, as set forth in Tennessee American Water Company's Privilege Log. The City of Chattanooga **does not** by its Third Motion to Compel seek an order requiring production of the matters described in item 1 on Tennessee American Water Company's Privilege Log.
