

NOTICE OF FILING AMENDED TARIFFS


Tennessee American Water Company ("TAWC") hereby provides this notice of filing of its amended tariffs. Pursuant to the Authority's Order during the April 4, 2011 Directors' Conference, TAWC is now filing two alternative sets of tariffs, one reflecting an across-the-board increase and one reflecting the settlement reached between TAWC and the Chattanooga Regional Manufacturers Association ("CRMA").

The first set of tariffs, attached as Exhibit A, reflects an across-the-board increase as ordered by the Authority on April 4, 2011. This set of tariffs had an effective date of April 5, 2011.

The second tariff, attached as Exhibit B, reflects the Settlement between the Company and the CRMA. The CRMA represents small and large industrial customers and commercial customers in Chattanooga. If approved by the Authority, this proposed tariff has an effective date of April 18, 2011. The Settlement was orally explained to the Authority during the hearing. It was filed as Exhibit 94 at the hearing and filed a second time on March 28, 2011. As explained in the Settlement, the second tariff makes revenue neutral adjustments to the rates for industrial customers only. These changes increase, by slightly more than the class average, both

the monthly meter charges and the volumetric rates in the industrial class lower rate blocks. There are corresponding reductions in the volumetric rates in the higher rate blocks in the industrial class. TAWC and CRMA submit that these adjustments are consistent with TAWC's cost of service study and believe that these adjustments will promote economic growth in the Chattanooga area. Under these tariffs, all industrial customers will experience a rate increase as a result of the Authority's decision in this docket but the reduced rates in the largest rate blocks will encourage existing customers to expand their plant activities and water usage and thereby encourage economic growth. All parties to this docket have stated they have no objection to the Settlement.
