According to our records, Mobilitie, LLC has not reported any New Hampshire revenue or New Hampshire customers for the last two years. New Hampshire RSA 374:27 and New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules Puc 451.11(b), *Forfeiture of Authorization*, specifies that, "A CTP...which indicates no activity in New Hampshire for 2 successive years following its registration shall, after notice from the commission, forfeit its authority to operate."

You are hereby notified that your CTP certification has not been exercised within the allotted time and, pursuant to RSA 374:27, is forfeited. CLEC applicants are required, by statute, to demonstrate their managerial, financial and technical abilities to provide the services for which they seek authority. To assist the Authority in its review of Mobilitie, LLC's application for Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide competing local exchange telecommunications services in Tennessee, you are requested to provide the following information:

- 1) Enclosed is the original surety bond. Please fill in the name and title of the Principal who signed page 1, as the signature is illegible.
- 2) Exhibit K lists the ILECs in Tennessee, however there is no signed and dated certificate of service indicating when these ILECs were served with notice of the filing of Mobilitie, LLC's application. Provide a signed certificate of service as proof that the ILECs in Tennessee have been given notice of this filing.
- 3) Pre-filed testimony indicates Mobilitie forfeited its authority to operate in New Hampshire and indicated a copy of the letter from the New Hampshire PUC explaining the forfeiture requirement attached as Exhibit N. However, no such letter was included with the application or Exhibit N. Please provide a copy of the letter from the New Hampshire PUC.

Please provide the above information by November 5, 2010. In accordance with TRA Rules, please submit either (1) thirteen written copies of your response or (2) four written copies and an electronic version and reference Docket No. 10-00191 on the correspondence.
