This matter is before the Hearing Officer of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority for the purpose of handling preliminary matters in preparation for a hearing before the Directors on alleged violations of Tenn. Code Ann. §§ 65-4-125(j) and 65-4-301(a)(1) against Advanced Tel, Inc. ("ATI" or the "Company"). Following additional investigation and upon review of the preliminary findings, which demonstrate that ATI's certificate of convenience and necessity to operate telecommunications services in Tennessee is revoked,<sup>1</sup> the Hearing Officer concludes that a Show Cause Order should not be issued and the docket file should be closed.
