

ORDER ADMINISTRATIVELY CLOSING THE DOCKET

On October 25, 2010, the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (“TRA”) opened the instant docket for the purpose of investigating Telecare, Inc. (“Telecare” or the “Company”) and initiating a show cause proceeding for alleged violations of Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-125(j) and Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-301(a)(1). Also at that time, the voting panel appointed General Counsel or his designee as Hearing Officer for the purpose of handling preliminary matters and preparing the matter for a hearing. Thereafter, as the Company remained unresponsive, the voting panel revoked the Company’s authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications services in Tennessee for non-payment of its annual inspection fee under Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-301(a)(1) on June 20, 2011.¹ Therefore, as Telecare is without authority to operate in Tennessee, the Hearing Officer hereby administratively closes the docket.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED.
