TO THE INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT


This matter came before Chairman Mary W. Freeman, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Sara Kyle of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on March 28, 2011 to consider the Petition for approval of the Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement negotiated between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Tennessee and Windstream Nuvox, Inc.¹ filed on January 26, 2011.²

Based upon a review of the Amendment, the record in this matter, and the standards for review set forth in 47 U.S.C. § 252, the Directors made findings consistent with those in the *Order Approving the Interconnection Agreement* issued on January 5, 2010 in Docket No. 09-00186 and unanimously granted the Petition.

¹ The original interconnection agreement and subsequent amendment were filed under the name NuVox Communications, Inc. d/b/a NuVox (the "Company"). The Company merged with Windstream Corporation in Docket No. 09-00184, and a name change to Windstream Nuvox, Inc. was approved in Docket No. 10-00051.

² The original interconnection agreement was filed and approved in Docket No. 09-00186. A subsequent amendment was filed and approved in Docket No. 10-00017.
