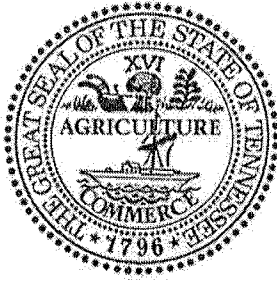



Small and Minority-Owned Telecommunications Business Participation Plan

Updated April 2011

1. Policy

The Other Phone Company, Inc. d/b/a PAETEC Business Services (“PAETEC”) is fully committed to and acknowledges the importance of supporting the participation of small and minority-owned telecommunications businesses in the telecommunications industry. It is PAETEC’s policy to provide opportunities for small and minority-owned telecommunications businesses to compete for contracts and subcontracts for goods and services to PAETEC in connection with its Tennessee operations. PAETEC is committed to the identification and selection of qualified small and minority-owned telecommunications businesses in its procurement processes. In addition, PAETEC is committed to provide information on programs, if any, to provide technical assistance to small and minority-owned telecommunications businesses, when and where available in Tennessee.

2. Goals

The goal of PAETEC’s Small and Minority-Owned Telecommunications Business Participation Plan is to identify those small and minority-owned telecommunications businesses that are qualified to provide goods and services, and to promote awareness among such businesses regarding the opportunity to develop business relationships with PAETEC.

3. Definitions

As used in this Plan,

- a. “PAETEC” means The Other Phone Company, Inc. d/b/a PAETEC Business Services.

- b. “Small Business” means a business with annual gross receipts of less than four million dollars pursuant to T. C. A. § 65-5-212.
- c. “Minority Business” means a business that is solely owned, or at least fifty-one percent of the assets or outstanding stock of which is owned, by an individual who personally manages and controls the daily operations of such business, and who is impeded from normal entry into the economic mainstream because of race, religion, sex or national origin and such business has annual gross receipts of less than four million dollars, pursuant to T. C. A. § 65-5-212.

4. Plan Implementation

- a. General

PAETEC will undertake efforts, as described below, to identify eligible small business and minority business providers of goods and services of the type it expects to use in its Tennessee operations. PAETEC will invite bids or proposals, or otherwise solicit offers from small and minority-owned telecommunications businesses to furnish goods and services to PAETEC in connection with its Tennessee operations. Selection of contractors will be based upon price and quality considerations, with full and equal consideration given to proposals submitted by small business and minority businesses, PAETEC will update this plan annually as required under Tennessee law.

- b. Plan Administration

The individual responsible for administering this plan is Mr. William Haas. Mr. Haas may be reached at One Marthas Way, Hiawatha, IA 52233 (tel.) 319-790-7295.

c. Administrator's Responsibilities

The Administrator's responsibilities pursuant to this plan include the following:

- i. obtaining and utilizing available resources for identifying Small Businesses and Minority Businesses interested and qualified in furnishing goods and services to PAETEC and to cultivate an awareness among such businesses as to any opportunities to develop business relations with PAETEC. These resources will include, among others, the following:
 - (1) Chambers of Commerce;
 - (2) the Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development;
 - (3) the U.S. Small Business Administration and the Office of Minority Business of the U.S. Department of Commerce;
 - (4) the National Minority Supplier Development Council;
 - (5) the National Association of Women Business Owners; and
 - (6) the National Association of Minority Contractors.
- ii. Serving as a resource for technical assistance to Small Telecommunications Business and Minority-Owned Telecommunications Business and will refer such businesses to sources of information and other technical assistance.
- iii. Ensuring that procurement packages are structured to maximize the participation of small businesses and minority businesses.

- iv. Ensuring inclusion of small businesses and minority businesses in those solicitations for products or services which they are capable of providing, and ensuring that PAETEC solicitations do not contain any language that may tend to restrict, inhibit or diminish the equitable opportunity for a small business or minority business to compete for contracts.
- v. Coordinating activities during any compliance review conducted by Tennessee state agencies.
- vi. Ensuring that records of solicitations and contract awards are maintained.
- vii. Preparing and submitting annual updates to this Plan.

5. Compliance Reports

PAETEC will submit reports, as may be required, for use in connection with subcontracting plans by the Tennessee Regulatory Authority and/or State of Tennessee. PAETEC will cooperate fully with all reasonable and appropriate surveys or studies required by the contracting agency in determining program compliance. However, PAETEC reserves the right to designate documents, reports, surveys and/or studies as “confidential” or “proprietary”.

6. Record Maintenance

PAETEC will maintain records relating to this Small and Minority Owned Telecommunications Business Plan for the purpose of evidencing the implementation of this policy, for use by PAETEC in evaluating the effectiveness of the Plan and in obtaining the goals of the Plan, and for use in updating the Plan on an annual basis with the Tennessee Regulatory authority, or as otherwise required.
