



PETITION OF VERIZON ACCESS FOR EXPEDITED REVIEW OF CENTRAL OFFICE CODE DENIAL

MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services ("Verizon Access") requests that the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("Authority") review the Pooling Administrator's denial of Verizon Access's application for a single Thousand Block of telephone numbers ("Thousand Block") in the Smyrna, Tennessee rate center; overturn that decision; and order that a Thousand Block be assigned to Verizon Access. Verizon Access requests this relief on the following grounds:

- 1. Verizon Access is a competitive local exchange carrier that provides local exchange service and exchange access service in Tennessee. Verizon Access's customers include large businesses that use direct inward dialing ("DID") arrangements to obtain telephone service for their employees at one or more locations.
- 2. A large business customer that uses a DID arrangement has selected Verizon Access as its service provider and requested that Verizon Access provide service using a block of 1000 consecutive numbers in the 615 NPA in the Smyrna rate center. Using consecutive numbers facilitates the installation and management of DID arrangements. The customer has stated that these numbers are critical to its ability to

effectively communicate with customers, dealerships, vendors and business partners. A confidential copy of the customer's letter explaining the circumstances is attached as Confidential Exhibit 1.

- 3. Because Verizon Access does not have a block of 1000 consecutive numbers in its inventory, it applied on March 9, 2011 to the Pooling Administrator, NeuStar, for a Thousand Block in the Smyrna rate center. Verizon Access's application is attached as Exhibit 2.
- 4. NeuStar denied Verizon Access's request on the same day Verizon Access submitted its application because Verizon Access only met one of the two FCC criteria that NeuStar applies, even though Verizon Access does not have the numbering resources needed to satisfy its customer's demands in the switch at issue. Verizon Access met the months-to-exhaust criterion, projecting that its number supply in the Smyrna rate center would be exhausted in 3.74 months, significantly below the six-month FCC benchmark. Verizon Access did not meet the number utilization criterion, however, with 33.3% utilization in the Smyrna rate center, which is under the FCC's 75% threshold. The Months-To-Exhaust and Utilization Worksheet is attached as Exhibit 3. NeuStar's denial of Verizon Access's application is attached as Exhibit 4.
- 5. The FCC has delegated authority to the Authority to address NeuStar's denial of a request for numbering resources, stating that "[w]e agree . . . that a safety valve mechanism should be established, and we delegate authority to state commissions to hear claims that a safety valve should be applied when the . . . Pooling Administrator denies a specific request for numbering resources." Moreover, the FCC has determined

that "a carrier should be able to get additional numbering resources when there is a verifiable need due to the carrier's inability to satisfy a specific customer request." Specifically, states "may grant requests for customers seeking contiguous blocks of numbers."

- 6. Based on this authority, the Authority has issued a number of orders addressing denials by NeuStar that release numbering resources to meet specific customer needs. For example, the Authority ordered NeuStar to provide AT&T Tennessee with numbering resources to meet the service requirements of the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga, even though AT&T Tennessee had been unable to satisfy the months-to-exhaust criteria.²
- 7. NeuStar's denial of sufficient numbering resources to Verizon Access to meet its customer's request is inconsistent with the FCC's position that "[u]nder no circumstances should consumers be precluded from receiving telecommunications services of their choice from providers of their choice for want of numbering resources." By refusing to grant numbering resources sufficient to meet the needs of Verizon Access's customer, NeuStar is preventing this customer from obtaining the service it wants from the carrier of its choice.
- 8. Verizon Access's request for a Thousand Block to meet its customer's request for a large block of contiguous numbers fits squarely within the framework established by the FCC for "safety valve" requests that the Authority is authorized to

grant. Verizon Access respectfully requests that the Authority direct NeuStar to assign a Thousand Block for the Smyrna rate center so that Verizon Access can satisfy its customer's request.

WHEREFORE, Verizon Access respectfully requests that the Authority review NeuStar's decision to deny Verizon Access's request for additional numbering resources, overturn that decision, and direct NeuStar to assign Verizon Access a Thousand Block in the Smyrna rate center.

Section 1.1 Contact information requires that Service Providers supply under "Block Applicant" the company name, company headquarters address, a contact within the company, an address where the contact person may be reached, in addition to the correct phone, fax, and e-mail address. The Pooling Administrator section also requires the Service Provider to fill in the Pooling Administrator's name, address, phone, fax and e-mail.

Section 1.2 Service Providers who need a thousands-block assignment or for an Location Routing Number (LRN) are required to fill in this section. If needed for an LRN, a CO Code Application needs to also be submitted to the PA. The Service Provider should supply the Numbering Plan Area (NPA); the Local Access Transport Area (LATA), which is a three-digit number that can be found in the Telcordia TM LERG TM Routing Guide. The Operating Company Number (OCN) assigned to the service provider and the OCN its parent company. An OCN is a four-character alphanumeric assigned by Telcordia TM Routing Administration (TRA).
