AND APPOINTING A HEARING OFFICER**



This matter came before Chairman Eddie Roberson, Director Sara Kyle and Director Mary W. Freeman of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on August 1, 2011 for consideration of the *Petition to Amend Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity* filed by Integrated Resource Management, Inc. d/b/a IRM Utility, Inc. on April 20, 2011. A Petition to Intervene was filed on May 19, 2011 by Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc. During the Authority Conference, the panel voted unanimously to convene a contested case proceeding and to appoint Kelly Cashman-Grams to act as Hearing Officer for the purpose of preparing the matter for a hearing before the panel, including but not limited to, setting a procedural schedule to completion, entering a protective order and ruling on petitions to intervene.
