


ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF FOR NINETY DAYS,
CONVENING A CONTESTED CASE AND APPOINTING A HEARING OFFICER

This matter came before Chairman Mary W. Freeman, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director Sara Kyle of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on May 9, 2011 for consideration of the *Petition for Emergency Relief* ("Petition") filed by Navitas TN NG, LLC on April 20, 2011 requesting emergency relief for approval to apply new service charges to all customer classes. The proposed tariff accompanying the *Petition* has an effective date of May 20, 2011. A *Petition to Intervene* was filed by the Consumer Advocate and Protection Division of the Office of the Attorney General on May 5, 2011. During the Authority Conference, the panel voted unanimously to suspend the proposed tariff for ninety days, from May 20, 2011 to August 18, 2011, to convene a contested case proceeding and to appoint a Hearing Officer for the purpose of preparing the matter for a hearing before the panel, including but not limited to, entering a protective order, setting a procedural schedule to completion and ruling on petitions to intervene and discovery issues.
