On April 12, 2012, the Consumer Advocate and Protection Division of the Office of the Attorney General ("Consumer Advocate") filed a *Petition to Intervene* in this matter. No formal action has been taken by the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("Authority") on the Consumer Advocate's Petition since it was filed. The Hearing Officer for this Docket, Director Sara Kyle, resigned from the Authority on March 13, 2013.
