

**ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENT
TO THE INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT**

This matter came before Chairman Mary W. Freeman, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Sara Kyle of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on June 6, 2011 to consider the Petition for approval of the Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement negotiated between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Tennessee and Nextel South Corp. filed on May 6, 2011.¹

Based upon a review of the Amendment, the record in this matter, and the standards for review set forth in 47 U.S.C. § 252, the Directors made findings consistent with those in the *Order Granting Nextel South Corp.'s and Nextel Partner's Motions for Summary Judgment* issued on July 17, 2008 in Docket No. 07-00161 and unanimously granted the Petition.


IT IS SO ORDERED.
