ORDER GRANTING APPROVAL OF NAME CHANGE

This matter came before Chairman Eddie Roberson, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director Sara Kyle of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on July 11, 2011 to consider the Petition filed by Windstream Corporation ("Windstream") to change the name of Knoxville Data Link, Inc. ("Knoxville" or "Company").

Knoxville was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide competing local telecommunications services, including exchange access telecommunications services, and facilities-based and resold exchange and interexchange services in Tennessee on September 21, 2006 in Docket No. 06-00186. Windstream acquired Knoxville through an indirect transfer of control on October 25, 2010 in Docket No. 10-00166. On May 16, 2011, Windstream filed a Petition to change the name under which Knoxville provides telecommunications services in Tennessee to Windstream Knoxville Data, Inc.

Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter and upon a finding that the Company has satisfied the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-1-.08, the panel voted unanimously to approve the name change.
