
**ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENT
TO THE INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT**


This matter came before Chairman Eddie Roberson, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director Mary W. Freeman of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on July 11, 2011 to consider the Petition for approval of the Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement negotiated between Citizens Telecommunications Company of the Volunteer State, LLC d/b/a Frontier Communications of the Volunteer State and Level 3 Communications, LLC filed on June 7, 2011.¹

Based upon a review of the Amendment, the record in this matter, and the standards for review set forth in 47 U.S.C. § 252, the Directors made findings consistent with those in the *Order Approving Interconnection Agreement* issued on March 17, 2003 in Docket No. 02-01341 and unanimously granted the Petition.
