According to the State Comptroller's Office your company was sent a tax equity payment in June 2011 resulting from Tennessee Code Annotated § 67-6-222. While this legislation entitles your company to receive such payments, it also requires that your company flow through the savings in the form of price reductions to business and/or interconnection customers. Specifically Tenn. Code Ann. § 67-6-222 (c) states in pertinent part:

To the extent that a person engaged in the business of providing telecommunications services subject to tax under title 67, chapter 6 experiences a net tax savings solely as a result of receiving a payment under subsection (b), such net tax savings shall inure to the benefit of business customers of such person through an adjustment in the price of telecommunications services provided by such person, including business interconnection services....Subsequent price adjustments shall be effective as of October 1, 2003, and as of October 1 of each year there- after, based on the actual payment received by each company under subsection (b) with respect to the immediately preceding June 30 payment date taking into account the cumulative amount of price adjustments previously implemented.

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

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
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
