ORDER GRANTING PERMISSION TO APPEAR PRO HAC VICE


This matter came before the Hearing Officer upon the filing of the Affidavit for Permission to Practice *Pro Hac Vice* (the "*Application*") for J. Tyson Covey filed on January 11, 2012 by BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Tennessee ("AT&T Tennessee").

Mr. Covey's *Application* states that he is licensed and in good standing in the State of Illinois and that no disciplinary actions or investigations of his conduct are pending against him. Mr. Covey agrees to subject himself to the jurisdiction of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("Authority") in any matter arising out of his conduct in such proceedings and agrees to be bound by the rules governing the conduct of attorneys appearing before the Authority. No party has objected to the *Application*.

This *Application* complies with Tenn. Comp. R. & Reg. 1220-1-2-.04(7). Accordingly, the *Application* by J. Tyson Covey for permission to practice before the Authority in the proceedings in this matter is granted.¹

The *Application* filed by J. Tyson Covey, attorney for AT&T Tennessee, is granted.
