Code Ann. § 7-59-301, *et seq.*, also known as the Competitive Cable and Video Services Act ("CCVSA"), TDS Telecom Service Corporation ("TDS") filed with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("TPUC") a *Third Amendment to Certificate of Franchise Authority*.
