Immediately following the regularly scheduled Authority Conference commencing at 1:00 p.m., CST, on September 12, 2011, the Tennessee Regulatory Authority will conduct a workshop on the need for a procedure, whether formal or informal, for using mediation or settlement discussions in contested cases before the TRA. The general purpose of the workshop is to explore ways to reduce the time and expense associated with TRA contested cases, particularly rate cases. Representatives of public utilities regulated by the TRA and members of the general public are invited to attend and to comment on the following topics:

- How mediation or other discussions can be used to facilitate settlement of, or otherwise streamline, contested cases, including rate cases.
- How and when mediation or settlement discussions should be offered as an option to parties to contested cases.
- How best to incorporate mediation or settlement discussions into the procedural schedules of contested cases.
- Whether and to what extent any mediation should involve TRA staff or third-party mediators.
- Any considerations that may apply specifically to rate cases.

Written comments may be submitted in advance of or at the beginning of the workshop.
