Yesterday, AT&T filed a motion in this docket, asking that the TRA consider either declining to convene a contested case or dismissing the complaint. I am writing to ask whether the Authority might make time for AT&T to be heard briefly on that motion before the TRA takes up the matter for the purpose of considering whether to appoint a hearing officer (as it is listed on the addendum to the agenda). In the event that the Authority agrees that it should exercise its discretion and decline to convene a contested case, then there would be no need to appoint a hearing officer. AT&T would need no more than ten minutes of time to speak to the basis for its motion and reply to any response offered by Access Point on that issue.
