On November 2, 2017, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-301, *et seq.*, also known as the Competitive Cable and Video Services Act (“CCVSA”), Spring City Cable TV, Inc. (“Spring City”) filed with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“TPUC”) a *First Amendment to Certificate of Franchise Authority*. In its First Amendment, Spring City supplements certain counties<sup>1</sup> previously described within its application filed August 30, 2011.
