Please accept one original and four (4) copies of this letter as notification that Business Telecom, Inc. d/b/a BTI is changing the name under which it will provide telecommunications services in Tennessee to Business Telecom, Inc. d/b/a EarthLink Business III.

BTI is certificated to provide resold interexchange telecommunications and/or operator services by an order dated September 12, 1995 in TRA Docket No. 95-02947; intrastate operator services and/or resold telecommunications services by an order dated March 12, 1998 in TRA Docket No. 98-00126; and competing local exchange and interexchange services as a reseller and as a facilities-based local exchange provider within Tennessee by an order dated October 7, 1998 in TRA Docket No. 98-00334 and is operating under Market Regulation. Upon approval of this Name Change, the Company will submit its access services tariff with the new name.

Included with this filing are the Certificate of Assumed Name registration filed with the Tennessee Secretary of State Division of Business Services and a copy of the customer notice. Also included with this filing is the company's updated Small and Minority-Owned Telecommunications Business Participation Plan and a check in the amount of \$25, representing the filing fee. The Company is exempt from the filing of a Surety Bond.



Updated Small Business Participation Plan

Small and Minority-Owned Telecommunications Business Participation Plan

Updated August 2011

1. Policy

Business Telecom, Inc. d/b/a EarthLink Business III ("EarthLink Business III") is fully committed to and acknowledges the importance of supporting the participation of small and minority-owned telecommunications businesses in the telecommunications industry. It is EarthLink Business III's policy to provide opportunities for small and minority-owned telecommunications businesses to compete for contracts and subcontracts for goods and services to EarthLink Business III in connection with its Tennessee operations. EarthLink Business III is committed to the identification and selection of qualified small and minority-owned telecommunications businesses in its procurement processes. In addition, EarthLink Business III is committed to provide information on programs, if any, to provide technical assistance to small and minority-owned telecommunications businesses, when and where available in Tennessee.

2. Goals

The goal of EarthLink Business III's Small and Minority-Owned Telecommunications Business Participation Plan is to identify those small and minority-owned telecommunications businesses that are qualified to provide goods and services, and to promote awareness among such businesses regarding the opportunity to develop business relationships with EarthLink Business III.

3. <u>Definitions</u>

As used in this Plan,

- a. "EarthLink Business III" means Business Telecom, Inc. d/b/a EarthLink Business III.
- b. "Small Business" means a business with annual gross receipts of less than four million dollars pursuant to T. C. A. § 65-5-212.
- c. "Minority Business" means a business that is solely owned, or at least fifty-one percent of the assets or outstanding stock of which is owned, by an individual who personally manages and controls the daily operations of such business, and who is impeded from normal entry into the economic mainstream because of race, religion, sex or national origin and such business has annual gross receipts of less than four million dollars, pursuant to T. C. A. § 65-5-212.

4. Plan Implementation

a. General

EarthLink Business III will undertake efforts, as described below, to identify eligible small business and minority business providers of goods and services of the type it expects to use in its Tennessee operations. EarthLink Business III will invite bids or proposals, or otherwise solicit offers from small and minority-owned telecommunications businesses to furnish goods and services to EarthLink Business III in connection with its Tennessee operations. Selection of contractors will be based upon price and quality considerations, with full and equal consideration

given to proposals submitted by small business and minority businesses, EarthLink Business III
will update this plan annually as required under Tennessee law.

b. Plan Administration

The individual responsible for administering this plan is the Vice President, Tax who may be reached at 1375 Peachtree Street, Level A, Atlanta, GA 30309.

c. Administrator's Responsibilities

The Administrator's responsibilities pursuant to this plan include the following:

- i. obtaining and utilizing available resources for identifying Small Businesses and Minority Businesses interested and qualified in furnishing goods and services to EarthLink Business III and to cultivate an awareness among such businesses as to any opportunities to develop business relations with EarthLink Business III. These resources will include, among others, the following:
 - (1) Chambers of Commerce:
 - (2) the Tennessee Department of Economic and Community

 Development;
 - (3) the U.S. Small Business Administration and the Office of Minority Business of the U.S. Department of Commerce:
 - (4) the National Minority Supplier Development Council;
 - (5) the National Association of Women Business Owners; and
 - (6) the National Association of Minority Contractors.

- ii. Serving as a resource for technical assistance to Small Telecommunications Business and Minority-Owned Telecommunications Business and will refer such businesses to sources of information and other technical assistance.
- iii. Ensuring that procurement packages are structured to maximize the participation of small businesses and minority businesses.
- iv. Ensuring inclusion of small businesses and minority businesses in those solicitations for products or services which they are capable of providing, and ensuring that EarthLink Business III solicitations do not contain any language that may tend to restrict, inhibit or diminish the equitable opportunity for a small business or minority business to compete for contracts.
- v. Coordinating activities during any compliance review conducted by Tennessee state agencies.
- vi. Ensuring that records of solicitations and contract awards are maintained.
- vii. Preparing and submitting annual updates to this Plan.

5. <u>Compliance Reports</u>

EarthLink Business III will submit reports, as may be required, for use in connection with subcontracting plans by the Tennessee Regulatory Authority and/or State of Tennessee. EarthLink Business III will cooperate fully with all reasonable and appropriate surveys or studies required by the contracting agency in determining program compliance. However, EarthLink Business III reserves the right to designate documents, reports, surveys and/or studies as "confidential" or "proprietary".

6. Record Maintenance

EarthLink Business III will maintain records relating to this Small and Minority Owned Telecommunications Business Plan for the purpose of evidencing the implementation of this policy, for use by EarthLink Business III in evaluating the effectiveness of the Plan and in obtaining the goals of the Plan, and for use in updating the Plan on an annual basis with the Tennessee Regulatory authority, or as otherwise required.
