Dear Mr. Foster;

The following numbered responses are in response to your email of June 15, 2012 in which you asked for clarification on several points. We have prepared the following, and hope that it answers all your questions adequately. We appreciate your assistance in this matter.

1) Question: Has Telmate, LLC placed bids or signed any agreements with any correctional facility in Tennessee to provide telecommunications services as of the date of this inquiry?

Response: No

2) Question: Is Telmate, LLC providing the "back office" services to its affiliate partner, Airespring, in any correctional facility in Tennessee? If so, what facilities?

Response: No

3) Question: How will local calls be routed when placed from a facility where Telmate is the telecommunications provider? Describe Telmate LLC's partnership arrangement with Airespring specific to Tennessee correctional facilities? Which carrier will contract with the inmate facility for services?

Response: Local calls will be routed via Voice Over Internet Protocol (VOIP) from Telmate hardware at the facility to one of our various Colocation facilities in Dallas or Oakland and then sent via Airespring, or one of our other termination providers, to the termination number of the dialed number by the inmate. Airespring is one of the call termination providers Telmate uses to complete calls from inmate facilities. Correctional facilities will contract with Telmate to provide Inmate Telephone Services to County Jails in Tennessee for recording and monitoring services along with a multitude of software functionalities provided by Telmate.
