FIRST AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF FRANCHISE AUTHORITY

On August 28, 2019, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-301, *et seq.*, also known as the Competitive Cable and Video Services Act ("CCVSA"), United Telephone Company ("United") filed with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("TPUC") a *First Amendment to Certificate of Franchise Authority*. In its First Amendment, United supplements certain municipalities and unincorporated areas within counties¹ previously described within its application filed December 12, 2011.
